# **DISTRICT AND COMMUNITY**

Glenbard Township High School District 87 is the fourth largest high school district in Illinois. Glenbard District 87 encompasses 45 square miles within DuPage County, a suburban area approximately 25 miles west of Chicago. The communities of Glen Ellyn, Carol Stream, Glendale Heights and Lombard lie within the district's boundaries, along with portions of Bloomingdale, Hanover Park, Addison, Downers Grove, Wheaton and unincorporated areas.

Glenbard District 87's four comprehensive high schools serve students in grades 9-12. These schools are: Glenbard East in Lombard, Glenbard North in Carol Stream, Glenbard South in Glen Ellyn and Glenbard West in Glen Ellyn.

Of Glenbard District 87's 7,703 students, 36% come from low-income families. The demographic makeup is: white 43.9%, Black 6.7%, Hispanic 29.8%, Asian 15.9%, American Indian 0.2% and two or more races 3.4%. *Source: 2022-23 Illinois Report Card* 


# **GLENBARD NORTH HIGH SCHOOL**

Glenbard North High School, which opened in 1968, is one of Glenbard Township High School District 87's four comprehensive high schools. Glenbard North serves the Chicago suburban communities of Bloomingdale, Carol Stream, Glendale Heights and Hanover Park.

Of Glenbard North's 2,127 students, 40% come from low-income families. Demographic makeup: white 32.9%, Black 6.3%, Hispanic 35.7%, Asian 21.6%, and two or more races 3.3%.

#### **TECHNOLOGY CENTER OF DUPAGE (TCD)**

Technology Center of DuPage is a Career Technical Education (CTE) campus for 24 high schools in DuPage County, IL. TCD offers a roster of intermediate-level elective career programs for juniors and seniors. Students enroll in one program at TCD and spend that year in hands-on occupational skill development, workplace skill development, and academic application. TCD courses are granted 1.5 credits per semester. Approximately 280 students from Glenbard District 87 attend TCD and participate in one of the following programs:

# **GRADING AND RANKING PROCEDURES**

Effective fall 2022, Glenbard Township High School District 87 changed from a 5.0 grading scale to a 4.0 grading scale. Advanced Placement, dual credit and honors course grades are weighted one grade point higher in GPA computation.

Advanced Placement, dual credit and honors courses (weighted):

• A= 5.0, B= 4.0, C= 3.0, D= 2.0, F= 0.0

All other courses (unweighted):

• A= 4.0, B= 3.0, C= 2.0, D= 1.0, F= 0.0

Weighted and unweighted grade point averages are calculated for each student every semester. All courses are included in these averages, except for pass/fail and audit courses.

For the class of 2025, the highest student GPA after junior year (6th semester) was:

- weighted: 4.6905
- unweighted: 4.0

Glenbard Township High School District 87 no longer reports individual class rank.


