# POLICY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES GLENBARD DIST 87 ADMINISTRATION CENTER

Monday, August 26, 2024

The Policy Committee held its monthly meeting at the administrative offices of Glenbard Township HSD87 on Monday, August 26, 2024. The meeting was called to order at 6:04 p.m.

Quorum requirements were met and the meeting was able to proceed.

### **Approval of Minutes**

The minutes of the Policy Committee meeting for May 13, 2024 were reviewed. No meeting was held in June or July.

Action: Motion made to accept minutes. – Mazzolini, seconded – Christensen, and carried (all ayes).

# Public Participation (Agenda Related)

Hearing no requests, public participation was closed.

Introduction of Committee members and student liaisons took place. Chambers provided a brief explanation to the students on how the committee runs and how policy is adopted/revised, as well as the differences between policy versus administrative procedures, and exhibits.

#### **Items for Discussion**

Policy 5:100 Staff Development Program; this policy was just updated and is being brought back due to Title IX changes in Federal law that were effective August 1, 2024.

Administrative Procedure 5:290-AP1 Educational Support Personnel Retirement Benefit is unique to Glenbard and not found in PRESS. It covers confidential staff - those not under a collaborative agreement who participate in IMRF. The policy had not been updated since 2013 and did not align with current guidelines under the retirement system for end-of-career earnings.

Policy 7:165 School Uniforms: it was identified during the ROE Compliance visit as the district needing to adopt the current PRESS version. It pertains to school uniforms and dress codes should a parent or legal guardian object. Concern was raised on the opening verbiage and it was agreed to revise the first line to start with "Should the school decide to have uniforms,..."

Policy 2:265 Title IX Grievance Procedure, 2:265-AP1 Title IX Response, and 2:265-AP2 Formal Title IX Complaint Grievance Process were rewritten in response to final regulations implementing Title IX which went into effect August 1, 2024. The new changes ensure that no person (student or staff) experiences sex discrimination, including sex-based harassment or sexual violence, in a school that offers a federally funded education. The language is directly from PRESS.

Exhibit 2:265-E1 Title IX Glossary of Terms had terminology revisions also recommended by PRESS.

Action: Motion made to move agenda items 1 through 7 forward to the Board – Mazzolini, seconded – Christensen, and carried (all ayes).

# Public Participation (Non-Agenda Items)

Hearing no other requests, public participation was closed on non-agenda items.

Action: Motion made to adjourn - Mazzolini, seconded - Christensen, and carried (all ayes).
